

(3.4) Facilities for Specially-abled Students

(Total Score-4)

The college provides a wheelchair to assist specially-abled students and visitors in moving safely and comfortably within campus. The wheelchair is kept on the first floor for easy access and is available whenever required, ensuring mobility support and promoting an inclusive environment. To ensure ease of access and safety, the college prioritizes seating and essential facilities for specially-abled students on first floor, minimizing the need to use stairs. A separate, dedicated washroom for specially-abled students is also provided on the first floor to ensure comfort, privacy and accessibility. These measures reflect the institution's commitment to maintaining an inclusive and barrier-free environment for all learners. With the provision of facilities for specially-abled students, including accessible washrooms and wheelchair support, the institution secures a total of 4 marks in this category.
