1	<p>College Development: To strengthen student facilities and upgrade the overall campus infrastructure, the following construction and development initiatives were proposed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Construction of a Green Room adjacent to the College Stage to support cultural programmes, guest preparation, and backstage management.➤ Installation of paver tiles on the approach road leading to the College Ground, ensuring smooth access, durability, and enhanced aesthetics.➤ Installation of paver tiles in the parking area in front of the College Gate to improve safety, convenience, and functional efficiency for students, staff, and visitors.➤ Construction of a Multi-Purpose Hall, which will serve as an Examination Centre and a dedicated space for students' indoor activities, workshops, cultural events, and other institutional functions.
2	<p>Workshops / Seminars: It was resolved in the meeting that regular workshops and seminars should be organised for faculty members to promote professional growth, academic upliftment, skill enhancement, and overall development. These initiatives will contribute to improving teaching-learning practices and keeping faculty updated with contemporary trends.</p>
3	<p>Virtual/Smart Classroom: To further enrich the teaching-learning environment, it was proposed to increase the number of Smart Classrooms, each virtually equipped with advanced digital tools, interactive technologies, and ICT-enabled resources. This initiative aims to enhance instructional delivery, promote active student engagement, and create a more dynamic and effective learning atmosphere.</p>
4	<p>Remedial Classes: To support academically weak students, the committee recommended the commencement of Remedial Classes with the objective of bridging learning gaps, strengthening foundational concepts, and enhancing overall academic performance.</p>
5	<p>Admission Portal: It was proposed to introduce an online admission system from the forthcoming academic session. A committee may be constituted to examine the feasibility of procuring or developing the required software and to supervise its implementation.</p> <p>Additionally, the College Prospectus Committee will prepare an updated online version of the College Prospectus, ensuring easy accessibility and wider reach for prospective students.</p>
6	<p>Library Upgradation: The committee emphasized the need for establishing a Digital Library, equipped with modern facilities such as e-resources, digital cataloguing, reading stations, and academic support tools to meet the evolving learning needs of students.</p>
7	<p>Strengthening of Career Counseling Cell: To guide students in making informed career choices, it was proposed to reinforce the Career Counselling Cell. The strengthened cell will provide information on various competitive examinations, employment opportunities, higher education avenues, and counselling sessions to help students plan their future effectively.</p>
8	<p>Inter-College Events: It was proposed to organize Inter-College Sports Events on the campus to provide students with wider exposure, promote healthy competition, and inspire them towards holistic development.</p>
9	<p>Cleanliness: To ensure a hygienic and student-friendly campus environment, it was proposed to repair and properly maintain all student toilets, along with strengthening the overall cleanliness and sanitation measures across the college.
