- 1) Orientation Session: July 28, 2025, to August 1, 2025 (mandatory for all students)
 - Uniform/Dress code (for students) for Orientation session is black trousers and white shirt.
- 2) Commencement of Classes: August 4, 2025 (for 1st-semester students)

Please note the following carefully:-

1. Attendance:--

- ➤ Minimum 75 % attendance is mandatory for students to be eligible for appearing in Term End Exams.
- > Parents are requested to regularly check their ward's attendance to avoid detention from term-end examinations.

Stay on top of attendance to ensure academic progress and in order to avoid detention from term end examinations.



- **2. Training Food:** Students will be provided training food during the lunch hour for the duration of their course. To be eligible for training food, students must:-
 - > Attend their first lecture.
 - > Continue attending all lectures throughout the day.
 - > Be well-groomed.

8. Hostel Allotment:-Hostel & Mess Charges Payment Details:

Hostel Fee is ₹65,000/- for the whole Academic Year and the payment modes are as under:

- i. Demand Draft (in favor of "Principal Institute of Hotel Management Hamirpur", payable at Hamirpur)
- ii. Debit / Credit Card / UPI

Note: Cash payment will not be accepted.

- > You can move in immediately after paying the hostel charges.
- > Review Hostel Rules on the institute website or office.

Please settle your hostel and mess charges accordingly!

12. Documents to bring:

The following documents, in original along with photocopies, must be submitted at the time of physical reporting:-

- a) Provisional Admission letter/ Seat Allotment Letter issued by NCHMCT
- b) Matriculation Certificate OR Certificate of equivalent qualification
- c) 10+2 Qualification Certificate
- d) Character certificate from the last attended school/ Institute in Original.
- e) School Leaving / Migration Certificate in Original.
- f) Medical Certificate in Original.
- g) Category Certificate (if applicable).
- h) 4 Passport Size photographs. (in white shirt only)

13. Uniform and Tool Kit:

14. Important Notice: Food Production Option

The institute offers an **ONLY VEG** option for students who prefer not to handle non-vegetarian items in Food Production/Bakery practical classes.

Note that:

- > Theory classes and exams are the same for all students.
- > Students who prefer the ONLY VEG option must specify their choice at the time of taking option
